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Project Title

An Interactive Website for *History of Music IV*

Audience

Undergraduate students enrolled in the *History of Music IV* course.

Pedagogical Issue

History of Music IV has long presented a pedagogical challenge: how to teach modern music—material unfamiliar to most students—in a large classroom setting while providing opportunities for serious discussion and individual exploration.

Solution

This project team proposes to develop an interactive website to enhance the learning environment of *History of Music IV*, a core required course for Peabody undergraduates. Four tools will be provided: a chat room to discuss and review matters introduced in class; an online writing center, with sample essays and guidance on writing about music; online practice quizzes, to help students prepare for exams; and additional resources, including links to external sites, to facilitate exploration of the parallels between twentieth-century movements in music and the visual arts.
